

As most prescriptions are on a 56-day prescribing schedule it should eliminate the need to order your medication in advance.

Scalloway Youth and Community Centre, Wednesdays 9am - 1pm

Wednesday 6th December - Joel from SIC housing will be along 10am - 12 noon. Housing officers can speak with you about a range of Housing related problems such as your rights and responsibilities as tenants, your current tenancy as well as applications for housing. If you are at risk of homelessness, they can provide advice on this too.

Wednesday 13th December - Lesley from Sport and Leisure will be in all day with her "kit for all" boxes of preloves sportswear. Anybody can take what they need or make donations should they wish too.

Wednesday 13th December - Social Security Scotland will be at the hub, they deliver devolved benefits in Scotland and ensure that people receive the right amount of money at the right time. They offer support for people across Scotland on low incomes, disabled people, carers, young people entering the workplace and help for people to heat their homes.
